Vicky received a Masters in Law at LSE in 1993 and qualified as a barrister in 1995. She worked as a government lawyer for over 15 years, specialising in drafting and advisory work. Vicky was the lead lawyer in medical ethics for the Department of Health for 4 years, with particular responsibility for end of life issues, consent to medical treatment and transplantation. From 2012 -2016, Vicky was the Head of Guidance at the Electoral Commission, providing regulatory advice and guidance to political parties, campaigners and candidates and regulating electoral events including the Scottish referendum in 2014, the 2015 UK Parliamentary general election and the Referendum on EU membership in 2016. Vicky moved to the Independent Parliamentary Standards Authority in July 2016 where she is Director of MP Support Services, leading and developing IPSA's operational functions and ensuring that the regulatory framework is put into operational effect. Vicky also sits on a hospice ethics committee.
